

Information Security Policy

Assembly's Information Security Management System (ISMS) is designed to ensure the confidentiality, integrity and availability of all the Information we store, handle or process. We have put a range of policies, procedures and controls in place to manage this.

Responsibility is a core Assembly value, and Data Security is central to everything we do. It's present in all our day-to-day business processes and technical controls.

To make sure we're always improving we have set measurable information security objectives that have been agreed based on the results of our risk assessment framework and our overall business strategy.

Our ultimate objective is to **eliminate business risk, or reduce it as far as practicable.**

Our risk assessment framework follows a defined methodology, utilising the principles of ISO 31000; and we apply controls from ISO 27001 (and other places) using a business risk approach.

We try to make sure all relevant staff, customers and third parties are aware of the ISMS, and their particular responsibilities within it, by making this policy easily available and running awareness and training campaigns.

We are committed to the continued review and improvement of our ISMS in order to reduce the risk of security incidents and ensure continued compliance with contractual, legal and other requirements.
